We will be inviting the previous year's campers in addition to sending out nearly 2,000 invitations to other Angel Tree children.

With that said, we are beginning to schedule staff for this camp season. We appreciate your dedication and service in years past, and our hope, is that you will consider serving the Lord again this year, at SSBC. I've seen the excitement on the returning campers' faces as they arrive, jumping off vans, and looking for those familiar faces. I can just imagine how excited they are to return to a place where they feel Christ's love lavished upon them.

So, if you can work a week, a month, or the whole camping season. Please return the commitment portion of this letter to us soon, to help with our planning. While we do not want this to be a deterrent to your coming to help, we would appreciate anyone who will pay for their background check to submit a check with your form. If not, we understand, and the camp will bear the cost.
